Each motoring offence will have its own specific set of circumstances and our fees will reflect the complexity of your individual case.

Our fees will therefore vary dependent upon for whether you simply require advice regarding your plea and the circumstances that gave rise to your charge or whether you require representation for the provision of an argument in mitigation or for example, an argument regarding Exceptional Hardship in order to increase your prospects of retaining your licence.

Our fees for dealing with Summary Only Offences (offences that are dealt with in the Magistrates Court) that do not have unexpected complications or where you do not intend to challenge the charge, will be in the range of £350 - £1250 + VAT in addition to our initial fixed fee consultation (£150 +VAT).

Prior to proceeding with your case, we would consider the full details of the papers which have been served upon you by the Court and discuss all of your options and the potential outcomes of your next steps.

Our fees as set out above do not include Counsel's fees for the provision of advice or their attendance at Court as it will be they who undertake the necessary advocacy. A separate quote will be obtained and agreed with you in respect of Counsel's fees before they are formally instructed.

We will always give you an individual cost estimate at the start of your matter which will take into account the specific features of your case.

In the event of your hearing being adjourned or cancelled for any reason our quotation may need to be revised to take in to account a further attendance at Court.
